What is bullying?

Bullying is where someone does something hurtful to another

Several Times On Purpose.

There are many **types of bullying.**

It is not a **tease or a joke** and a trusted adult needs to know.

Bullying is not:

A fall out with a friend.

An accident.

Something that happens once.

What should I do if I see someone else being bullied?

If you see someone being bullied, it is important that you **help them.**

You should **never walk away** and **ignore it.**

Talk to a trusted adult or a Restorative Ambassador. **Speak To Other People**

Never feel scared to tell someone.

What to do if you are being bullied:

Ask them to stop.

Ignore them and walk away.

Use the class worry monster or box to tell someone.

Talk to friend, a trusted adult or a Restorative Ambassador.

Speak To Other People

Use the **worry monster** to tell us what has happened.

Remember it is **NOT** your fault.

DON'T

Get angry or fight back – try **not to react.**

Hide it or keep it to yourself.

Do as the bully says

Think it is your fault.
