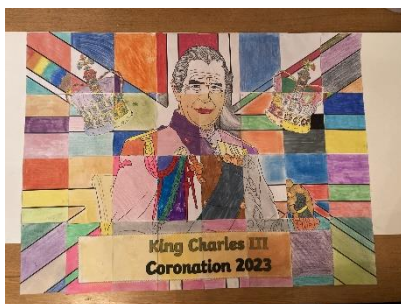
Our Curriculum
