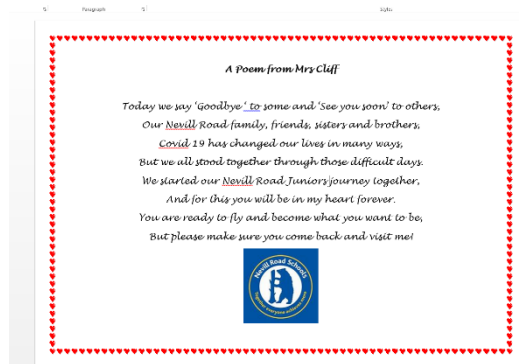
Well we have made it to the end of another school year and what a year it has been! I have everything crossed for a bit more normality in September....
