Thank you to all the parents and carers who were able to attend today's Resilience workshop. Resources from the session will be shared next week on school spider.

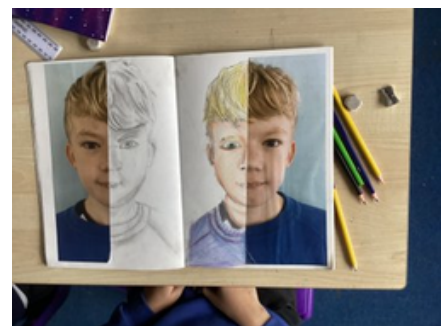
