Our Curriculum

In Art, Year 3 have been learning about botanical drawings. The children used the magnifying glasses to look closely at the flowers before trying to sketch them in detail.

Year 6 have thoroughly enjoyed making blueberry muffins using our kitchen area. They weighed out all of the ingredients independently. They children also made vegetable pasta sauce, deciding whether to make it chunky or blended.

In Year 5, we have been learning about irreversible changes. We combined bicarbonate of soda with white wine vinegar and were amazed when a balloon inflated, then shot across the classroom. This was because a gas - carbon dioxide - was formed through a chemical reaction. This change was definitely irreversible!
