Every year Nevill Road Juniors is frequented by mining bees along the path by the stage area.

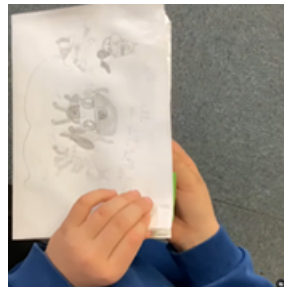
They are a solitary bee that live in loose groups underground. Meaning they live alone but are normally found in clusters. They have a life cycle of 5 – 6 weeks and during that time they are excellent pollinators and provide a great service to the local wildlife.

They are fairly harmless and due to living alone are very unlikely to sting as they don't have a colony to protect.

If you do see them they are nothing to worry about and we have coned off the area as a precaution during breaks and lunch.
