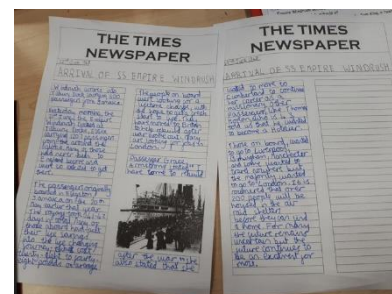
Parent Newsletter – 26.11.21



Dear Families,

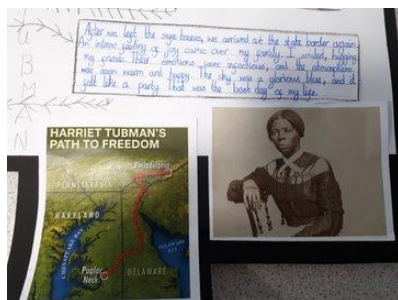
Every where you look today, there are children taking pride in their learning! We have had a fantastic writing week inspired by Black History Month. The quality of writing across school is superb!
