Covid Reminder

If your child shows any symptoms of Covid 19 (new, continuous cough, a high temperature or loss of taste and smell) they are to stay at home until the PCR test result is confirmed as negative or for 10 days if positive. Please contact Track and Trace for information of the return to school date. Household members should take a LFD test for 10 days if they do not have symptoms and someone in the house has tested positive. If you come in to close contact with a positive case it is recommended that you take a PCR test.

Should a member of staff or child test positive, parents of the children in the bubble will be contacted and asked to take a PCR test.
