Dear Families,

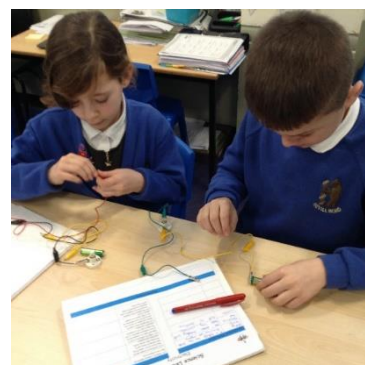
The sun has been shining and we have had a very active week here at NRJ. Year 6 have been using their orienteering skills to find locations around the school site.
