Here is a beautiful poem about the environment written by Olivia.

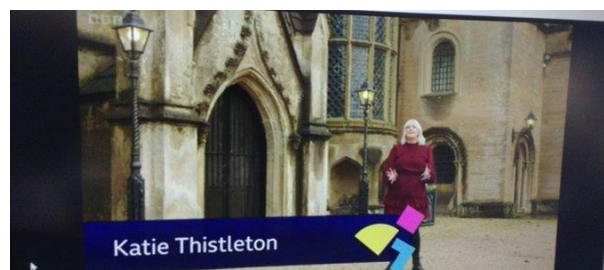
I love the environment and everything around,
